With wheat flour, rice, pulses, oil, salt and sugar

**₹ 1500**

## Hygiene Kit

With toothbrush, toothpaste, towel, sanitary pads, nail cutter, mosquito net, washing soap and powder, bathing soap, buckets and mug

**₹ 1800**

to support a family with hygiene kit to promote personal hygiene and cleanliness

## Water Filter

To provide safe drinking water to a family

to ensure a family have access to safe drinking water

## Shelter Kit

With tarpaulin, rope, aluminium vessel and bowl, ladle, saucepan, spoons, plates, steel glasses, *kadai*, blanket, clothes, sleeping mat, candles & lighter
